Providing Storm Relief

In the Bay Area we have been experiencing the climate crisis for years. The winter storms from late December into January caused significant damage that led to a disaster declaration by the Governor and the President. I joined my colleague Congresswoman Eshoo in a letter to President Biden urging him to declare San Mateo County a major disaster area, allowing residents and businesses to apply for financial relief from FEMA.

I will be introducing legislation in the coming month to help our communities better protect homes and property from the impacts of extreme weather, especially for lowincome homeowners.



Protecting Our Planet for Future Generations

I am as committed as ever to protecting our planet. I recently voted against H.R.1, the Polluters over People Act, and gave my first House Floor speech arguing against this shameless giveaway to Big Oil at the expense of vulnerable communities and ecosystems.

We urgently need policies to preserve our environment, reduce greenhouse gas emissions and create a clean energy economy. With that in mind, I am pleased to be assigned to seats on the Natural Resources Committee and the Science, Space, and Technology Committee, which will allow me to prioritize issues like climate change, the life sciences, and an innovation economy that works for everyone.



Taking on Gun Violence

The beginning of this year also left San Mateo County residents shaken and in mourning as seven of our neighbors became the latest victims of a deadly mass shooting in Half Moon Bay. We must act now to end the national shame of gun violence which claims more than 100 American lives every day.

That is why I support the reinstatement of an assault weapons ban, and recently joined my colleagues on the steps of the Capitol to advocate for commonsense gun violence prevention policies.

Listening to You

In the months ahead, I will be home in the district as frequently as possible so I can hear directly from you about your priorities and concerns. One of the first cities I visited was East Palo Alto where I spent time at the senior center, Nuestra Casa, and the Boys and Girls Club. I am also planning monthly Coffee with Kevin events across the district, and I hope to see you there.
