Since being sworn in, I have **cosponsored over 280 bills**, including legislation to make it easier for workers to unionize, restore reproductive freedoms, strengthen protections for the LGBTQ+ community, and ensure the wealthiest pay their fair share. I have also been committed to **addressing national crises that disproportionately impact our District like climate change and the affordability crisis**, and remain laser-focused on **protecting our democracy and fighting for social equity**.

PROVIDING CLIMATE CHANGE SUPPORT



In response to the atmospheric rivers that devastated our community last winter, I introduced H.R.4296, the **Weatherization Resilience and Adaptation**

Program (WRAP) Act, which would provide financial assistance to low-income homeowners and affordable housing providers to make changes to homes and property that would make them more resilient to climate-driven disasters.

PREVENTING GUN VIOLENCE

Recently, I joined **Gun Violence Prevention Task Force** Chair Rep. Mike Thompson, Speaker Emerita Nancy Pelosi, Lt. Governor Eleni Kounalakis, Rep. Barbara Lee, and other local leaders at a San Francisco press conference to push for federal legislation to prevent gun violence. I am a proud cosponsor of the **Assault Weapons Ban, Bipartisan Background Checks Act**, and **COOL OFF Act**, which would institute a waiting period for handgun purchases.



PROTECTING OUR DEMOCRACY

I am proud to serve on the **Task Force on Strengthening Democracy**, which is closely monitoring attempts to gut voting rights and make it more difficult to engage in the political process. I am also proud to cosponsor the **Freedom to Vote Act** to expand ballot access for all Americans.



FIGHTING THE AFFORDABILITY CRISIS



As a father of young twins, I care about the future of all our children, which led me to join members of the **Dads Caucus** for an interview on MSNBC to talk about the importance of helping families with paid family and medical leave,

expanding the **Child Tax Credit**, and increasing access to childcare. In the coming weeks, I will be introducing the **Poverty Line Act**. This bill represents the first meaningful reform to the way we calculate poverty in America in over half a century. The changes proposed in my bill would increase equity and fairness and help millions of families gain new access to critical safety net programs.

HONORING VETERANS

It was my honor to present my first flag to the widow and family of **Vietnam veteran Ernest Leo De Soto who vanished after his plane crashed in 1969**. For 54 years, his wife Joyce wondered what happened to him. Earlier this year, the Air Force informed her that her late husband's remains were found and identified. **De Soto received a military burial with full honors at Golden Gate National Cemetery in June**, finally offering some closure to his family.
