A BILL

To require the Secretary of the Army to consult with stakeholders in determining the scope of contracts entered into for the purposes of maintenance dredging, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Dredging Coordination
- 5 Improvement Act".

1 SEC. 2. MAINTENANCE DREDGING REQUIREMENTS.

2	(a) Consultation and Prioritization.—In deter-
3	mining the scope and performance timeline to be included
4	in any contract entered into on or after the date of enact-
5	ment of this Act with an entity to carry out maintenance
6	dredging, the Secretary—
7	(1) shall—
8	(A) consult with stakeholders, including
9	the applicable non-Federal sponsor and other
10	relevant entities determined by the Secretary;
11	and
12	(B) the extent practicable, prioritize the
13	completion of maintenance dredging in waters
14	used for commercial and navigation activities,
15	maintenance dredging that is needed for emer-
16	gencies, maintenance dredging that is needed to
17	accommodate environmental windows (as de-
18	fined by the Secretary), and maintenance
19	dredging that supports other activities in which
20	there is an important national interest before
21	the completion of maintenance dredging in
22	waters used primarily for other activities, such
23	as recreation, or for purposes other than to fa-
24	cilitate commerce or navigation; and
25	(2) notwithstanding paragraph (1), may deter-
26	mine the scope and performance timeline to be in-

- 1 cluded in such contract without consultation with
- 2 stakeholders that are not a party to such contract,
- 3 if the Secretary determines that an emergency exists
- 4 or there is an important national interest at stake.
- 5 (b) COMMUNICATION.—Upon receiving information
- 6 about changes with respect to the performance of mainte-
- 7 nance dredging and determining that such changes are
- 8 reasonably likely to affect the period of performance of
- 9 a contract for such dredging, the Secretary shall notify
- 10 the applicable non-Federal sponsor of such changes not
- 11 later than the third business day after the date on which
- 12 the Secretary received such information.
- 13 (c) Capability Numbers.—With respect to any
- 14 maintenance dredging activity, the Secretary shall, upon
- 15 request, make the respective capability numbers for such
- 16 activities available to the non-Federal sponsor of such ac-

- 18 (d) Secretary Defined.—In this section, the term
- 19 "Secretary" means the Secretary of the Army, acting
