The past year has been one of the most challenging in America's history. We've seen attempts to undermine our democracy, efforts to strip away crucial federal services that so many in our country need, and challenges to many of our priorities here in California.

I have heard from many of you who are deeply concerned about how the Trump Administration's harmful policies have impacted our families here in California – from cutting child care and school meal programs, to slashing Medicaid that helps people access basic health care.



Representing you in Congress is the greatest honor of my life, and I remain deeply committed to being your voice in Washington, D.C. Earlier this year, after being hospitalized for 10 days following complications from knee surgery, I went straight from my hospital bed to SFO the moment doctors cleared me to fly to D.C. so I could vote NO on the Republicans' cuts to federal services.

I continue to believe that we need a government that protects our most vulnerable, helps to lower costs for working families, and creates an economy that works for all of us.

At the start of this Congress, I was also selected to serve on the influential House Committee on Energy and Commerce, which oversees issues related to health care, energy policy, consumer protection, technology and telecommunications, the automotive industry, and more. This role gives me an important opportunity to advocate for the priorities of our community and ensure your voices are heard on these critical issues.

Standing Up for Our Democracy

We're seeing harrowing attacks on America's system of checks and balances. This is a five-alarm fire for our democracy. As a Co-Chair of the Congressional Task Force on Strengthening Democracy, I have been working every day to keep our elections free and fair and ensure the Trump Administration follows court orders. I will continue to vigilantly safeguard voting rights.

Gathering with the Community & Staying Connected

I was grateful for the chance to host frequent in-person and digital town halls where we could talk openly about the issues affecting our district, answer questions, and share ideas for moving forward together.



I also loved being out in the community visiting small businesses and local schools, touring health centers, and joining neighborhood events throughout the district. Whether it was meeting federal workers at SFO during the shutdown, standing with neighbors at "No Kings" demonstrations, or lending a hand at holiday food and toy drives, each conversation reminded me why this work matters.

Introducing New Legislation

I'm excited to share that I wrote and introduced 19 bills this year, and I co-sponsored hundreds more. Here are just a few:

Emergency Alerts: During a crisis, seconds matter. Emergency alerts save lives when used properly, but too often we've seen how alert failures can turn deadly. That's why I introduced the bipartisan *Resilient Emergency Alert Communications and Training (REACT) Act*, to improve emergency alert and warning systems.

Autonomous Vehicles: Driverless cars are here, yet we don't fully understand how safe they are because companies aren't required to report key pieces of data, like how many miles they're driving. I introduced the *AV Safety Data Act* to increase transparency and accountability on data reporting requirements from AV companies.

Hearing Aid Coverage: As someone who is hard of hearing, I know firsthand how essential hearing aids are and how expensive they are. Seniors on fixed incomes often struggle to afford the cost, so I introduced the bipartisan *Help Extend Auditory Relief (HEAR) Act* to expand Medicare coverage for hearing aids.

Climate Change Adaptation: Rising sea levels and extreme rainfall are causing groundwater levels to rise, threatening homes and infrastructure. My *Groundwater Rise and Infrastructure Preparedness Act* would ensure communities have data-driven resources to help protect people, property, and infrastructure.
