Dear Chair Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Glen Park Pump Station Replacement project in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Brisbane, located at 50 Park Place, Brisbane, CA 94005.

The funding would be used to rehabilitate and upgrade the Glen Park Pump Station, a critical component of the City's public water distribution system. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the existing pump station is more than 50 years old and has reached the end of its useful service life. It no longer meets the pumping capacity required to reliably deliver safe, clean drinking water to Brisbane residents.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Section 1452 of the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 U.S.C. 300j-12.
