I am requesting funding for the Integrated Green Stormwater Infrastructure Streets project in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City/County Association of Governments of San Mateo County, located at 555 County Center, Redwood City, CA 94063.

The funding would be used to deliver three street-scale projects that combine safety upgrades with improved stormwater management in underserved, high-density neighborhoods near schools. This project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because investment in street-scale green stormwater infrastructure integrates flood reduction, water quality treatment, and multimodal safety improvements. This project will make the streets more reliable and safer for all who use them in three underserved communities.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 23 U.S.C. § 133.
