Dear Chair Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Central Millbrae Watershed project in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Millbrae, located at 621 Magnolia Avenue, Millbrae, CA 94030.

The funding would be used to install modern stormwater diversion pipelines and increase overall drainage capacity, thereby protecting homes, businesses, and public infrastructure from flood related damage, reduce roadway hazards during storm events, and ensure reliable access for emergency vehicles and first responders to address persistent flooding and strengthen stormwater management in a vulnerable residential neighborhood. This project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because will reduce long term maintenance and emergency response costs, prevent costly damage to public and private property, and improve the overall resilience of the City's stormwater system.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C. §§ 5305(a)(2) and 5305(a)(4).
