Dear Chair Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the I-280 Geneva Ramp Signal Safety Improvements project in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the San Francisco County Transportation Authority, located at 1455 Market Street 22nd Floor, San Francisco, CA 94103.

The funding would be used to advance a signal system upgrade as recommended by the 2024 I-280 Northbound Geneva Avenue Off-Ramp Study. The project will improve the northbound off-ramp with signal upgrades including vehicle detection equipment to allow for signal timing adjustments for vehicle demand and improved coordination between Caltrans and San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency signals. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because these upgrades will help relieve congestion occurring on and near the off-ramp, facilitate safer movements through the intersection and on the mainline freeway, and allow for better coordination between signals and nearby transit activity.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 23 U.S.C. § 133.
