Dear Chair Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the San Francisquito Creek, Section 205 project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, located at 450 Golden Gate Ave., 4th Floor, San Francisco, CA 94102.

The funding would be used to protect hundreds of homes, businesses, and transportation infrastructure in East Palo Alto and Menlo Park from flooding by removing natural and artificial creek channel constrictions in two locations and constructing adjacent top-of-bank floodwall protection to increase channel capacity. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because past flooding from the San Francisquito Creek has impacted more than 5,000 properties in the adjacent cities and a critical regional freeway, U.S. Highway 101.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Section 205 of the Flood Control Act of 1948 (P.L. 80-858), as amended.
